Although research misconduct was repeated in a long history of science, recent two infamous cases, namely the STAP cell scandal and the Kato lab case drew huge public attentions in Japan. In the latter case, many papers published in high profile journals from Kato lab were found to contain inappropriately manipulated data. As a former member of his lab, I will discuss research environment which drove many young scientists to research misconduct. I will also talk about activities in the University of Tokyo to prevent research misconduct as well as an interactive training tool developed by ORI.
